- c. Surety Bond callable upon Thirty percent (30%) of the demand issued by a surety or insurance company duly certified by the Insurance Commission (IC) authorizing the issuance of such security

RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF DIVERSION DAM AND ITS APPURTENANT STRUCTURES FOR LIBANG RIVER IRRIGATION PROJECT CONTRACT NO. R13-LRIPD-C-1

WHEREAS, the National Irrigation Administration (NIA) advertised/posted the Invitation to Bid for the Construction of Diversion Dam and its Appurtenant Structures for Libang River Irrigation Project, Invitation to Bid No. R13-LRIPD-C-1, in the PhilGEPS and NIA websites on April 12, 2024 (Annex "1"). The Invitation to Bid was also posted in conspicuous places within the NIA premises;

WHEREAS, in response to said advertisement, twenty (20) prospective bidders submitted their Letters of Intent (LOIs), presented their respective PCAB Licenses, and purchased the bid documents, as follows:

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WHEREAS, observers from the Commission on Audit (COA), Philippine Institute of Civil Engineers (PICE), Philippine Constructors Association, Inc. (PCAI), NIA-Internal Audit Services (NIA-IAS), National Irrigation Administration Employees Association of the Philippines (NIAEASP), and Volunteers Against Crime and Corruption (VACC), were invited to attend the Prebidding Conference scheduled on February 20, 2024 at 2:00 P.M. Copies of the letters of invitation are hereto attached as **Annexes "22"** to "**28**";

WHEREAS, the Pre-bidding Conference held on April 23, 2024, 2:00 P.M. was attended by the representative of seven (7) prospective bidders, copy of the Minutes of the Pre-Bidding Conference is attached hereto as **Annex "29"**;

WHEREAS, Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 1 was issued to all prospective bidders covering NIA's modification in the Bidding Documents, copy of the same is attached hereto as Annex "30";

WHEREAS, observers from the COA, PICE, PCAI, NIAEASP, NIA-IAS, were all invited to attend the Opening of Bids scheduled on May 9, 2024 at 2:00 P.M., at BAC-A Conference Room, 6th Floor, Building A, NIA Complex, EDSA, Diliman, Quezon City.

WHEREAS, on May 9, 2024, eighteen (18) out of twenty (20) prospective bidders submitted their bids on time, while *DANBEL CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY / METRO GEAR CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION (JV)*, and *NORTHERN BUILDERS* submitted their respective letters stating the reason of their non-participation as follows:

1) DAN-BEL CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY / METRO GEAR CONSTRUCTION CORP. (Joint Venture)	Authorized Managing Officer, Mr. Charles Aldwin M. Carpio, submitted a letter on May 8, 2024 informing that they are withdrawing their intent to participate on the bidding of the above- mentioned project. At the same time, Ms. Bella B. Beray, Authorized Managing Officer of Dan-Bel Construction and Supply, denied any collaboration with Metro Gear Construction Corporation.
2) NORTHERN BUILDERS	General Manager Victor M. Angeles submitted a letter on May 9, 2024 informing that they are formally withdrawing their intent to participate in the bidding of the above-mentioned project.

WHEREAS, the eligibility/technical component of the bids submitted by the eighteen (18) bidders were opened and read in public to determine if they contain all the bid requirements for the Eligibility, Technical and Financial Components using a non-discretionary "**pass/fail**" criterion;

WHEREAS, seventeen (17) out of eighteen bids were rated "PASSED" by the BAC-A, while the bid submitted by *KYRO BUILDERS, INC.* was rated "FAILED" by the BAC-A due to non-submission of Certificate of Site Inspection;

WHEREAS, the BAC-A informed all the bidders present during the Bid Opening that their bid proposals will be subjected to a detailed evaluation, copy of the minutes is attached hereto as Annex "31";

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group (TWG) conducted a detailed evaluation and checking of arithmetical computations on the submitted bid proposals which were rated "passed" during the Bid Opening. The result of the evaluation contained in the Bid Evaluation Report (BER) prepared by the TWG, attached as Annex "32";

WHEREAS, the bids as read-out, and as calculated in comparison to the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) were tabulated as follows:

WHEREAS, discrepancies were noted on fourteen (14) out of seventeen bids, four (4) of which exceeded the Approved Budget for the Contract as shown on the above table;

WHEREAS, in the BAC-A meeting held on May 20, 2024, the Technical Working Group (TWG), in their presentation, reported that sixteen (16) out of seventeen bids were rated failed, copy of the letters notifying them of their disqualification and reasons thereof attached as Annexes "33" to "48";

WHEREAS, the TWG reported that the bid of *PERRC*, *INC.* / *JIREH-B CONSTRUCTION (JV)* was complying and passed the criteria in the bidding documents;

WHEREAS, the BAC-A, on the same meeting, agreed with the findings of the TWG, and declared the bid of *PERRC, INC. / JIREH-B CONSTRUCTION (JV)* as the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB);

WHEREAS, among the sixteen (16) bidders who were informed of their disqualification, only ARN BUILDERS, INC., SUPERIOR BT INC., P.L. SEBASTIAN CONSTRUCTION, INC. / MAER SUMMIT KONSTRUKT CO. (JV), DAN-BEL CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY / AAA ROCK CONSTRUCTION CORP. (JV), and KAEL CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY / ROSBILL CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY (JV) filed a Request for Reconsideration, copy of their respective letters attached as **Annexes "49"** to **"53"**;

WHEREAS, the BAC-A in its letter dated June 11, 2024, denied the Requests for Reconsideration due to lack of merit and/or filing out of time, copy of the letters attached as Annexes "54" to "58";

WHEREAS, the BAC-A Chairperson, instructed the TWG and Secretariat to conduct the post-qualification process on the bid of *PERRC, INC. / JIREH-B CONSTRUCTION (JV)*, and to officially inform said bidder that its bid was declared as the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) and require them to submit within five (5) calendar days, the post-qualification documents, copy of the letter is attached hereto as **Annex "59**";

WHEREAS, as part of the post-qualification process, the BAC-A, requested in writing the following government offices dealing with infrastructure projects for information on the status of on-going contracts of *PERRC*, *INC*. and/or *JIREH-B CONSTRUCTION*, if there is any:

WHEREAS, ARN BUILDERS, INC., SUPERIOR BT INC., P.L. SEBASTIAN CONSTRUCTION, INC. / MAER SUMMIT KONSTRUKT CO. (JV), DAN-BEL CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY / AAA ROCK CONSTRUCTION CORP. (JV), and KAEL CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY / ROSBILL CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY (JV) did not file a protest within the prescribed period;

WHEREAS, the TWG, with the assistance of the Secretariat, conducted Post-Qualification of *PERRC, INC.*, and *JIREH-B CONSTRUCTION* on June 13, 2024 to June 20, 2024;
