WHEREAS, in accordance with the Republic Act No. 10149, Government -Owned and -Controlled Corporations (GCG) is mandated to institutionalize the Performance Evaluation System (PES) over government -owned and -controlled corporations (GOCCs);

WHEREAS, GCG Memorandum Circular No. 2017-02 provides for the framework for the setting of organizational targets requiring GOCCs to submit Board-approved Proposed Performance Scorecard, Charter Statement and Strategy Map, among other requirements;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved on motion duly seconded, the NIA Board of Directors approved the following 2021 Performance Agreement Negotiation Requirements required under Section 3 of GCG Memorandum Circular 2017-02 and as presented by the Management, to wit:

(a) Charter Statement and Strategy Map including the Mission and Vision of the Agency (PES Form 1); and

(b) Proposed Cy 2021 Performance Scorecard (PES Form 2).

This is to formally transmit the Charter Statement and Strategy Map (Annex A), and 2021 Performance Scorecard (Annex B) of NIA. The same is to be posted in NIA's website, in accordance with Section 43 of GCG Memorandum Circular (M.C.) No. 2012-07.1

The NIA's proposed Performance Scorecard submitted through its letter dated 16 November 2020² was MODIFIED based on the discussions made during the online technical panel meeting (TPM) held on 07 January 2021 and evaluation of supporting documents submitted through its letters dated 26 January 2021³ and 16 April 2021.⁴

We take this opportunity to remind NIA that Item 5 of GCG M.C. No. 2017-02⁵ mandates GOCCs to submit Quarterly Monitoring Reports and upload the same in the GOCC's website within thirty (30) calendar days from the close of each quarter. NIA is thus requested to submit its revised Quarterly Targets based on the attached Scorecard upon submission of the 2nd Quarter Monitoring Report for 2021.

Finally, under GCG M.C. No. 2017-02, GOCCs can no longer renegotiate the targets set in their Performance Scorecards for the current year. Thus, any request for modification in the 2021 Performance Scorecard will instead be considered during the validation of the reported annual accomplishments.


